ReSPECT is a process that creates personalised recommendations for a person's clinical care in a future emergency in which they are unable to make or express choices. It is a new approach to encourage people to have an individual plan to try to ensure that they get the right care and treatment in an anticipated future emergency when they may not have the capacity to make or express choices.
