1. Purpose

The purpose of this report is to ask the East Region Programme Board to agree the attached Learning Disability MCN Workplan for 2019-2021.

2. Background

As part of the MCN governance and quality assurance process the LD MCN is required to report on its achievements and to produce a workplan which sets out its priorities for the forthcoming year.
