Heather used the aggregation tool to cleanse data and double checked it with original data. ISD had a number of guestions in relation to analysing/interpreting the data. 1. Number of individual people We discussed the issue of individuals moving between community and inpatients in relation to first and final HEFs as the HEF cannot be transferred. We thought it best/easiest to treat as episodes of care rather than trying to follow patients thought the system. Therefore question one is not an issue. 2. Age of individual Data shows current age, so if first HEF done in 2016, there will be a three year age difference. This therefore needs a simple formula for ISD to calculate age at time of HEF. 3.Individual details may change over time There was an acknowledgement that the HEF shows a point in time. If someone developed dementia, this might not be a factor in first HEF, but affect the detriments to health in a further HEF. The HEF was not designed to address this, therefore may not cause an issue. 4.HEF Score 'Outliers' There are a range of HEF scores with a few extremes of scores of 0% or 91%. These are probably mistakes and thankfully low in number. These may be able to be removed as we check them. Derek will go back to Fiona at ISD with our answers to these questions and get the first step of analysis started. Derek discussed varying the stages of analysis, rather than getting too much perhaps not helpful information all at once. Suggestion of looking at the Welsh data analysis and what was helpful to them.
